Re-Registration Fee:

• <u>Re-Registration</u>: All parents with children who have decided to remain with QTLC for the summer and the following school year are required to reregister in good faith, toward, their commitment to return.

Kindergarten & First Grade Only

- All children entering the program after the start of school must pay tuition from the 1st day of school regardless of when they start. Thirty (30) days written notice is required in order to withdraw.
