3. If Montgomery County Schools have a delayed opening, QTLC will open on time and Kindergarten will open at 9 a.m.

Special Information Regarding School-Age Enrichment Program: If MCPS is delayed, the *Before School* Enrichment program will be **cancelled** for the day. In this instance, parents are advised to drop off their children directly at the elementary school. The *After School* Enrichment program will commence as usual and parents will pick up their children from QTLC.
